LET'S MARVEL AT THE METHOD

WITH ANNA JAHJAH

You have been given a role in an upcoming production. The character is your diametrical opposite. This character walks, talks and even looks different from you. They have a different life story from yours. How do you let go of all your experiences and suddenly become someone completely new? Many well-known actors have had to gain weight, lose weight, adopt an accent, shave their heads all in the pursuit of inhabiting their roles. Some have had to live in new environments so they could better understand their characters' lives. This type of immersion in a character's experience, known as *method acting*, was first introduced by the theatre practitioner, Konstantin Stanislavski. In the early 20th century, he developed a range of specific techniques to help actors *become* the character. In this workshop we will explore the various techniques involved in method acting, including the use of emotional memory and Stanislavski's *Magic If* and *Illusion of the First Time* strategies. Thanks to Stanislavski, the actors you watch on stage or on screen are believable, and you can be too! ***Wear comfortable clothing (black if possible).***

LEGALLY EVER AFTER

If only the land of fairy tales had a great set of laws to protect the common good - not nearly as many grandmothers would be eaten by wolves, houses blown down, or young women forced to work as unpaid maids. In this workshop you'll join *Wunce, Arpon & Thyme Lawyers* and bring the force of the legal system to bear on a few literary miscreants. There is an awful lot of 'breaking and entering' and trespassing in this far away land – remember Hansel and Gretel, various wolves and Goldilocks, just to mention a few. Were their acts criminal? We'll explore the laws of evidence and see if we have enough permissible evidence to bring MR B.B. Wolf to the dock. We'll step up as prosecutors or defence lawyers for Cinderella's stepfamily members after charges of false imprisonment and withholding wages have been brought against them. We'll also explore how jail sentences are decided and what parameters judges have to operate within. Can we ensure that our criminals who have done the crime, do the time?

SCREAM, SPIN, DROP AND CRASH: THE SERIOUS SCIENCE OF SCARING US OUT OF OUR WITS

How can science have you screaming, spinning, dropping, crashing and half-scared out of your wits? Thrill rides, that's how! These amazing machines rely on physical, centripetal and gravitational forces to create thrills, screams and that sinking stomach feeling that we all either love or hate. Physics is the scientific study of many things, such as motion, force, energy, light and sound. It includes gravity, friction and speed – all things that contribute to the way thrill rides operate. Engineers who design these adrenaline pumping rides use the laws of science to simulate danger, while the rides themselves are usually very safe. You will design, build and experiment with different free fall systems, such as direct plunge rollercoasters and swing type rides, and construct our own model that utilises the transformations between potential and kinetic energy to almost detach our heads from our bodies. IT'S ALL IN THE MIND WITH PROFESSOR CORPUS CALLOSUM
