WHAT is the G.A.T.E.WAYS Ignite program?

A one day program where students take part in two half-day workshops related to either language and literature, or maths and science. The program is led by specialist educators with expertise in these areas.

WHY would my students participate?

After two years of intermittent school closures, these workshops provide an opportunity to re-ignite the curiosity of your highly-able students. The enrichment workshops are designed to meet the specific needs of gifted and talented students and develop STEM skills or language skills, as well as critical and creative thinking skills. Workshops cover topics both above and beyond the school curriculum.

HOW will the program run?

The programs are run at **your school** with **your students**. Two presenters attend on the day and provide all equipment and resources necessary.

Frequently Asked Questions

How many rooms do I need to provide? Two rooms are needed from 8am to 3.30pm for one day.

How many students do I nominate? We require at least 30 students from your school in total to participate. We recommend 15-20 from Years 1-3 and 15-20 from Years 4-6. Have a chat with us if your needs are different.

Are your presenters vaccinated? Yes, our presenters can provide evidence of vaccination and meet current state government requirements.

Does the school need to provide a teacher to supervise? Our presenters have VIT registration or WWCC so there is no need to arrange supervision during workshops.

Who pays for the program? Parents enrol directly with G.A.T.E.WAYS and pay for the program. Schools may choose to subsidise part or all of the fee.

How do I nominate students? Simply forward the school nomination letter to parents and we take care of the rest.
