FRAME IT

At Art Centre Melbourne's The Channel

Use technology to tell your story! In this 2 day workshop, you will create 2 pieces of work. You will create a digital photostory of an event or series of events that have had an impact on you. That could be your life story, a family event or holiday, the story of someone close to you, or an experience you've had you want to share! The other piece of work will be a digital photostory of a certain aspect of Melbourne life. We will take you out on a guided walk to take photographs of one element of Melbourne you find interesting, maybe cafes, or fashion, or street art. We will then come back to The Channel to write and produce your Melbourne photostory. Both photostories will feature your own photographs, your voice narrating the story, and sound design including sound effects and music.

Aims and Objectives of FRAME IT

Students will learn:

- The basic principles and theory of digital photography
- Narrative writing for video
- Digital video editing
- Advanced editing techniques
- · To record and edit digital audio
- To select library music to fit desired atmosphere
- About finalising and file format considerations

Course Outcome

Participants will create two short films, one featuring photos from a significant event in their life (Day 1) and another featuring a narrative about an aspect of Melbourne (Day 2). Both films will include voice over, animated photos, effects, text and a soundtrack. Note that the days may be reversed depending on the weather.

Preparation for the Course:

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- Students should prepare 10 15 photos of an event or a person in their life that they would like
 to make a short film about. These should be brought on Day 1 on a USB (please don't bring them
 on your phone or camera)
- Students should think about the story they would like to tell with the photos
- Students will need to bring a digital camera or smartphone both days
- Note: depending on weather, the programs designated for the days may be reversed

About the presenters

Zoe Rinkel, Eva Popov and Rosalind Hall are Creative Learning Educators at The Channel at Arts Centre Melbourne. All are working musicians and composers/songwriters and experienced in music and multimedia education. They have all worked at Arts Centre Melbourne presenting G.A.T.E.WAYS courses for many years and have extensive experience in teaching filmmaking, animation, studio recording, music composition and multimedia production to young people.

 - Children should dress appropriately for their workshop in casual clothes. A cap or hat will be required for outside breaks.
 - Bring a snack, lunch and writing materials pencils, pen, paper <u>as well as any specific</u>
 <u>requirements mentioned in program.</u>
 . We may go to Southbank during lunchtime so your child may wish to purchase some food or drink.
 - Children should not bring any products containing nuts to the program. If students are
 anaphylactic and have had an Epipen or Anapen prescribed, an in date EpiPen/Anapen must
 be brought to each session. We are unable to admit a child to the program who comes without
 this medication. If your child is going to buy lunch at Southbank you must bring written
 permission for this.
 - We regret that G.A.T.E.WAYS staff are unable to dispense medication. Except in an emergency.
 - Once applications have been confirmed, there can be no full course refunds, nor will there be
 any refunds for missed sessions. Unfortunately, if any conflict with school commitments arises
